Nestled in the rolling hills of North Carolina's Piedmont, Stanly County, blessed with a moderate climate and untouched by urban sprawl, is an area rich in historical, natural and recreational assets.

The county seat of Albemarle boasts a variety of beautiful and diverse neighborhoods, both historic and new. It also boasts a variety of parks and recreational facilities. The historic downtown area is a gem of beautifully maintained and restored old buildings, and is home to restaurants, retail businesses, and antique stores.

The beauty of Stanly County's countryside, lakes, ancient Uwharrie Mountain range and the nearby Uwharrie National Forest provide excellent opportunities to enjoy the outdoors while nearby cities provide outstanding sports and cultural amenities in a convenient driving distance.

The county boasts a wide variety of recreational pursuits that include gold-mining, golf, wineries, art galleries, a fine theater, small town cruise-ins and the unique entertainment offered by an old-fashioned drive-in theater.

The jewel in the crown of Stanly County's countryside is Morrow Mountain State Park. Over 400,000 visitors come here every year from far and wide to enjoy camping, hiking, horseback riding, boating, swimming, fishing and superb views.

Lake Tillery and Badin Lake were both created by dams on the Yadkin/Pee Dee River and offer miles of un-spoilt shoreline, boating and superb fishing. Lake Tillery covers over 5,000 acres with 104 miles of shoreline and has a maximum depth of 70 feet, while Badin Lake covers an area of 5,350 acres and has 115 miles of shoreline and a maximum depth of 200 feet.

SCHOOLS IN STANLY COUNTY

The school system in Stanly County, North Carolina is a source of pride for local residents and the business community. It is one of the few counties that boast an excellent public school system, a community college and a university.

In addition to public schools, including Gray Stone Day School, a public charter high school on the Pfeiffer University campus, our county also gives parents several private-school and early-childhood options. Agriculture, supported by agri-business, is the number one industry in Stanly County. We rank high in the state for local beef cattle and field crop production.

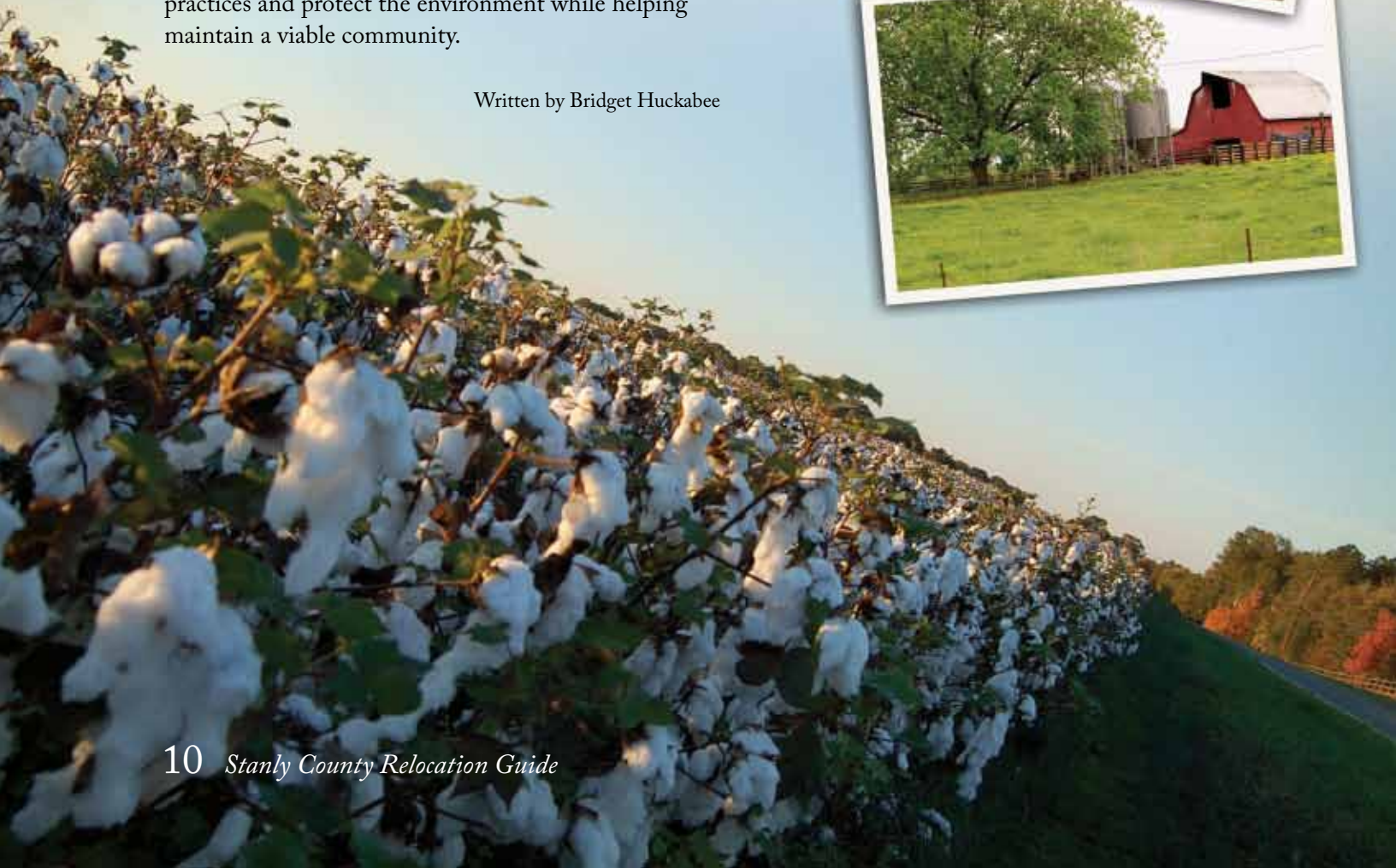
One field crop, cotton, is a source for North Carolina manufactured jeans, bed sheets and shirts. From October through December, Rolling Hills Gin built in 1996 to service Stanly County farmers and surrounding counties, processes cotton 14 hours a day, 6 days a week.

Viticulture is growing and wine from Stanly County's three wineries is increasing in sales as well as increasing tourism throughout the area. The local foods movement is also growing and Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is becoming popular throughout the county. The county also boasts a strong 4-H Youth Development program for ages 5 through 18 years of age.

The County Center of NC Cooperative Extension provides citizens with research-based knowledge through the land-grant University system including NC State University and NC A&T State Universities. Over the years this has helped improve farming practices and protect the environment while helping maintain a viable community.

Stanly County, one of sixteen counties's making up the Charlotte Region, an area encompassing parts of both North and South Carolina with Charlotte as its hub, stretches 109 miles north to south and 115 miles east to west. It is home to over 2.3 million people and is centrally located between the northeast, Midwest and southern Florida markets. With well over five million people living within a 100-mile radius of Charlotte, the Charlotte Region stands as the nation's fifth largest urban region. Further, an unmatched 62% of the US population lives within a 650 radius of Charlotte - a day's drive or a short 90-minute flight.

Stanly County Airport is a county owned, joint civil-military, public use airport. It is located five miles northeast of the central business district of Albemarle. This airport is included in the National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems for 2011-2015, which categorized it as a general aviation facility. The airport also serves as a regional training site for the North Carolina Air National Guard.

Stanly County Airport covers an area of 800 acres and has two runways. The new 10,000 square foot terminal building includes a large lobby for pilots and passengers and an impressive lounge area.
