STARNES JEWELERS NAMED A 2016 RETAILER OF THE YEAR BY THE NC RETAIL MERCHANTS ASSOCIATION

Charlotte, NC (April 25, 2016) – Starnes Jewelers of Albemarle was recently recognized as a 2016 Retailer of the Year, one of four leading retail businesses to receive the honor from the North Carolina Retail Merchants Association (NCRMA). The award was presented during NCRMA's Annual *Retailer of the Year* awards luncheon at the Charlotte City Club on April 20th.

Starnes Jewelers is a family-owned business started in 1898 by F.E. Starnes and has been run by only three generations in its 118 year history. It has been a landmark in downtown Albemarle since the Starnes building, which houses the jewelry store, was built in 1907.

Starnes Jewelers and its owners have been honored many times over the years. It was one of the first jewelry stores in North Carolina to be admitted to membership in the prestigious American Gem Society (AGS) of which it has been a member for over 70 years.

Gene Starnes, the present owner, along with his brother-in-law, Chris Bramlett, have held roles of importance to the jewelry industry both on the state and national level. Starnes and Bramlett has served as president of both the NC Jewelers Association and the North Carolina Guild. Starnes has also served as a director of the Independent Jewelers Organization and the National Bridal Service. Bramlett has been a trustee and director of the AGS where he also chaired the education committee for several years. In 2001, AGS presented Bramlett with the Robert M. Shipley Award, the highest honor given in the jewelry industry.

Although Starnes Jewelers is not the multi-faceted operation it was in its early years, the store is still more than just a jewelry store. While maintaining a focus on fine jewelry and gifts, including a complete selection of bridal goods, locals also come to the store to buy their tickets to cultural affairs such as Uwharrie Player productions and other civic events.
